But whilst the manufacture of these pictures of nothing was ostensibly straightforward, their subsequent theorisation has been anything but. More than a history, *Monochrome: Darkness and Light in Contemporary Art* is the first account of the monochrome's lively role in contemporary art. Liberated from the burden of representation, the monochrome first stood for emancipation, an ideological and artistic impulse that characterised the avant-garde of the early twentieth century. Historically, the monochrome embodied the most extreme form of abstraction and pure materiality. Yet more recently, adaptations of the art form have focused on a broader range of cultural and interpretive contexts. Provocative, innovative, and timely, this book argues that the latest artistic strategies go beyond stylistic concerns and instead seek to re-engage with ideas around authorship, process, and the conditions of the visible as they are given and understood through both light and darkness. Discussing works by artists such as Katie Paterson, Hiroshi Sugimoto, Tom Friedman, Bruno Jakob, Sherrie Levine, and Ceal Floyer, the book shows that the debates around an artwork's form and its possibility for meaning that the monochrome first engendered remain very much alive in contemporary visual culture.

After the End of Art Arthur C. theories cannot explain the difference between Andy Warhol's Brillo Box and the product found in the grocery store After the End of Art addresses art history pop art people's art the future role of museums and the critical contributions of Clement Greenberg whose aesthetics based criticism helped a previous generation make sense of modernism Tracing art history from a mimetic tradition the idea that art was a progressively more adequate representation of reality through the modern era of manifestos when art was defined by the artist's philosophy Danto shows that it wasn't until the invention of pop art that the historical understanding of the means and ends of art was nullified Even modernist art which tried to break with the past by questioning the ways in which art was produced hinged on a narrative
