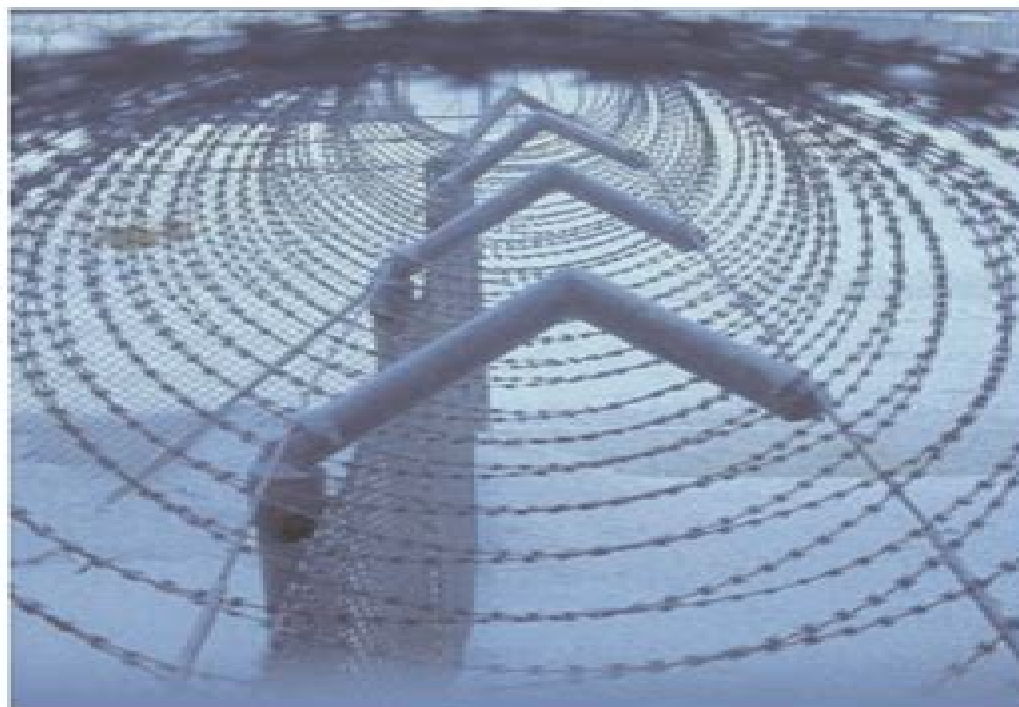




Correctional Psychiatry

A significant amount of forensic psychiatric work occurs with prison populations. The US has one of the highest rates of incarceration among Western societies. According to the Bureau of Justice Statistics, at the end of 2002, 2,166,260 individuals were under the custody of correctional authorities in federal and state prisons, local jails, and military and juvenile facilities. The rate of incarceration was 701 inmates per 100,000 residents, meaning that 1 in every 143 US residents were incarcerated in federal or state prison or a local jail.

There is ample evidence that the incarcerated population is not a representative sample of the US general population. In fact, gender, racial, and socioeconomic differences are present and have been extensively analyzed. In addition to those, significantly elevated rates of mental illness are present in the incarcerated group. The higher prevalence of psychiatric disorders among prisoners and jail inmates was initially described in the mid 1970s. Since then, these findings have been consistently replicated.

The reasons for the increased rates of mental illness among incarcerated individuals are the source of much controversy. Theories that originated in Europe in the early part of the 20th century suggest that societies tend to institutionalize a stable number of individuals, and that an inverse relationship exists between prison and mental hospital populations. There is also evidence supporting the hypothesis that deinstitutionalization and the criminalization of the mentally ill are the culprits for the mentioned
