Caradonna, 2012-02-17 Public academic prize contests the concours acad mique played a significant role in the intellectual life of Enlightenment France with aspirants formulating positions on such matters as slavery poverty the education of women tax reform and urban renewal and submitting the resulting essays for scrutiny by panels of judges In *The Enlightenment in Practice* Jeremy L. Caradonna draws on archives both in Paris and the provinces to show that thousands of individuals ranging from elite men and women of letters artisans and peasants participated in these intellectual competitions a far broader range of people than has been previously assumed Caradonna contends that the Enlightenment in France can no longer be seen as a cultural movement restricted to a small coterie of philosophers or a limited number of printed texts Moreover Caradonna demonstrates that the French monarchy took academic competitions quite seriously sponsoring numerous contests on such practical matters as deforestation the quality of drinking water and the nighttime illumination of cities In some cases the contests served as an early mechanism for technology transfer the state used submissions to identify technical experts to whom it could turn for advice Finally the author shows how this unique intellectual exercise declined during the upheavals of the French Revolution when voicing moderate public criticism became a rather dangerous act

Rousseau's Republicanism Megan K. Dyer, 2023-09-12 Reading Rousseau as a republican thinker might seem almost too obvious a proposition All the same the Genevan is often struck from accounts of modern republicanism given by those associated with the revival of republican thought At the root of this omission is perhaps the greatest puzzle of Rousseau's republicanism is that it demands his readers untangle the omission In bringing the republic's sovereign power into the Enlightenment Rousseau pairs it both with the premise of natural liberty and equality and also with an account of man singularly unsuited to realizing the rightful consequences of this shared nature Looking to both major works and lesser known writings this book demonstrates that in the face of human finitude and the formidable demands of right Rousseau crafts a robust yet judicious account of the republic Through comparison with various republican lineages its chapters explore Rousseau's engagement with leading moral and political problems that have defined and redefined republicanism attaining virtue preserving liberty sustaining the social order orienting persons toward the common good and having the law rule over men The goods of civil association are always precarious yet Rousseau nonetheless recognizes in human community an answer to the great problems of his thought those of inequality unhappiness and unfreedom

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
