

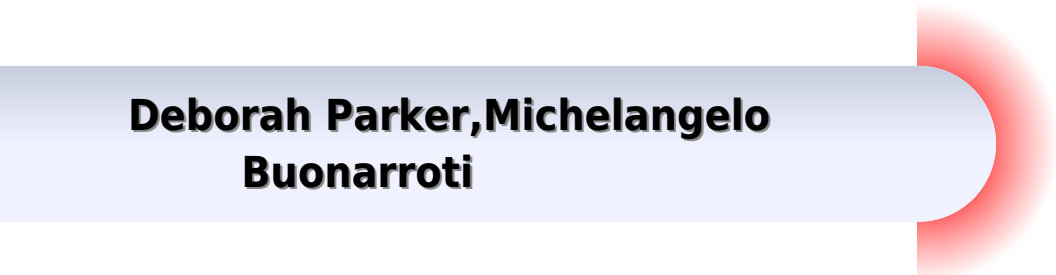

Correspondence Roger Chartier, Alain Boureau, Cécile Dauphin, 1997 In this book Roger Chartier and his associates explore the history of a cultural practice that has become common and widespread the writing of letters They begin by examining the invention of norms for writing letters in the Middle Ages and the fixing of these norms in popular manuals of various kinds They then analyse the letter writing models developed in the ancien regime showing how these models were linked to court literature on the one hand and to the popular books distributed by pedlars on the other Finally they discuss the models of letter writing developed during the nineteenth century The nineteenth century they argue was a decisive period in the history of letter writing partly because of the rapid rise in rates of literacy and partly due to broader social and economic transformations which increased the need for writing letters By exploring the ways in which practices of letter writing have changed over the centuries this path breaking book sheds light on an everyday cultural practice which has created new ways of thinking of feeling and of relating to others as well as to oneself

Letter Writing as a Social Practice David Barton, Nigel Hall, 2000 This book explores the social significance of letter writing Letter writing is one of the most pervasive literate activities in human societies crossing formal and informal contexts Letters are a common text type appearing in a wide variety of forms in most domains of life More broadly the importance of letter writing can be seen in that the phenomenon has been widespread historically being one of earliest forms of writing and a wide range of contemporary genres have their roots in letters The writing of a letter is embedded in a particular social situation and like all other types of literacy objects and events the activity gains its meaning and significance from being situated in cultural beliefs values and practices This book brings together anthropologists historians educators and other social scientists providing a range of case studies that explore aspects of the socially situated nature of letter writing
