in powerful and creative ways Comics do not stand outside of literature cinema or any of the other arts but rather enliven the reciprocal relationship between the verbal and the visual language that informs all of these media As such the discussion demonstrates how fields such as graphic medicine graphic justice and comics journalism contribute to existing theoretical and analytics debates including critical visual theory trauma and memory studies by offering a broad ranging yet cohesive analysis of cultural memory and its representation in print and digital comics

comic strips published in the Progressive Era were dynamic spaces in which anxieties about race ethnicity class and gender were expressed perpetuated and alleviated The proliferation of comic strip children white and nonwhite middle class and lower class male and female suggests that childhood was a subject that fascinated and preoccupied Americans at the turn of the century Many of these strips including R F Outcault s Hogan s Alley and Buster Brown Rudolph Dirks s The Katzenjammer Kids and Winsor McCay s Little Nemo in Slumberland were headlined by child characters Yet no major study has explored the significance of these verbal visual representations of childhood Incorrigibles and Innocents addresses this gap in scholarship examining the ways childhood was depicted and theorized in late nineteenth and early twentieth century comic strips Drawing from and building on histories and theories of childhood comics and Progressive Era conceptualizations of citizenship and nationhood Lara Saguisag demonstrates that child characters in comic strips expressed and complicated contemporary notions of who had a right to claim membership in a modernizing expanding nation **USA Today** ,2005

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
