These topics range from the control of food intake to the biophysical mechanisms of transduction and the design of food flavors in the food industry. The responses and organization of special sensory pathways are described in regard to their development, morphology, composition, electrophysiological and biochemical responses. Details are presented at several levels to appeal to researchers in molecular biology, membrane biophysics, human psychophysics, neuroanatomy and chemistry. Current research is described in the context of what preceding studies have revealed and the chapter authors are among today's most active and highly respected researchers in the field of chemical senses.

Some of the topics covered in the book are the origins of neocortex, the differentiation of sensory thalamo-cortical systems in early phases of mammal evolution, the predominance of the auditory system in carnivore effects of brain stem lesions on the normal prepotency of sound, the logarithmic intensity function of single peripheral units and sensory neocortex and the evolution of intelligence. The organization of somatic central projections is covered. The pure convergent cortical projections are discussed. The text describes the Weber function and Fechner's conjecture. A study of the human somesthetic intensity function is presented. A chapter is devoted to the peripheral nerve responses. Another section focuses on the physical correlate theory of perception of intensity. The book can provide useful information to doctors, neurologists, students and researchers.

The vestibular system is discussed in full. The electrophysiological analysis of the monkey's eyes is defined as well as the methods that are being used to examine the primate vision. Sensory Coding in the mammalian nervous system George Somjen, 2013-04-09 Great advances have been made in the area of sensory physiology during the last few decades and these developments seem to be asking for a comprehensive review that is manageable in size and cohesive in content This volume has been written with that goal in mind In the first place I would like to thank Mr R van Frank of Appleton Century Crofts for asking me to do the job and my wife for persuading me to do it for writing it was an enjoyable task Much of the discussion of factual data set to print here evolved in question and answer sessions in courses given to students in physiology psychology and medicine and to physicians training in neurology neurosurgery and psychiatry Besides my students I had in mind while preparing this text my professional colleagues laboring on their lecture notes under circumstances perhaps not unlike my own The material is divided in two parts The first deals with the manner of representation of sensory information in peripheral nerves the so called first order code The second half of the text deals with the handling of sense data by the central nervous system One reason for dividing the material in this way is that many of the features of the first order code are common to all sensory modalities The intensity the place the rhythm the quality of stimuli are encoded by rules which are applicable albeit with appropriate modifications to all senses Furthermore these rules of coding are today rather well understood *Contributions to Sensory Physiology* William D.
