 time This selected correspondence reveals a highly intelligent woman filled with self doubt berated by her mother for her
 selfishness yet persisting in her total immersion in her art Close friends with Manet Degas and Mallarmé Morisot married
 Manet's brother and shared ideas with colleagues who included Cassatt Monet Renoir and Pissarro The letters edited by
