Cymatics, the study of wave phenomena, is a science pioneered by Swiss medical doctor and natural scientist, Hans Jenny (1904-1972). This comprehensive edition documents over 14 years of his meticulous experiments using auditive sound to excite powders, pastes and liquids into life-like, flowing forms. The stunning array of images reflects a variety of patterns found throughout nature, art and architecture. The photographs in this book are of entirely "natural" phenomena, there are no computer generated images.



This revised edition contains the complete English language text of the bilingual edition published in 1967, Kymatio/Cymatics, (from the Greek to kyma, "pertaining to waves") as well as the entire text from Cymatics, Vol. II, published in 1974. It also includes all of the photographs from both of the original editions (over 350, including 16 full-page, color plates), which illustrate these amazing phenomena in vivid detail.

Dr. Jenny's cymatic images are truly awe-inspiring, not only for their visual beauty in portraying the inherent responsiveness of matter to sound (vibration) but because they elicit a deep recognition that we, too, are part and parcel of this same complex and intricate vibrational matrix. Perhaps Dr. Jenny's greatest gift has been to provide a concrete methodology to illustrate such principles as inspired the ancient Greek philosophers Heraclitus, Pythagoras and Plato, and the great Copernican cosmologists Giordano Bruno and Johannes Kepler.

No single phenomenal category can be claimed as the original principle. We cannot say, in the beginning was number, or in the beginning was symmetry, etc. These are categorical properties which are implicit in what brings forth and what is brought forth. By using them in description we approach the heart of the matter. They are not themselves the creative power. This power is inherent in tone and in sound."
