Section 1: Native Peoples in the Americas

- **Native Peoples Develop Diverse Cultures**
 - Debate over when and how the first people came, most likely from NE Asia
 - Believed a growth of glaciers between 38,000 and 14,000 B.C. led to a drop in sea levels and created a land bridge in the Bering Strait, known as **Beringia**
 - First people likely came over 20,000 to 25,000 years ago during a warming trend following mammoths, moose, bison, and wholly rhinoceroses
 - Eventually, ice returned, and migrants pushed inland
 - Mammoths disappeared approx. 10,000; people became dependent on fish, plants, other meats to survive
 - Some communities began establishing agriculture, led to permanent settlements
 - Horticulture- people working on small plots of land with simple tools- developed in present-day Mexico
 - Beans, squash, and corn offered a well-rounded diet
 - High yields produced surpluses of food allowed for trade
 - Led to economic developments and diversification of societies
 - Small bands of hunters and gatherers in deserts and forests
 - Civilizations on wetlands, grasslands, and mountains
- **The Aztecs, Mayas, and the Incas**
 - Large, wealthy civilizations that were dominant in the 15th century
 - **Aztecs** (Mexico) built Tenochtitlan (present day Mexico City)
 - Used irrigation and cultivation, developed written language
 - Class structure: priests and nobles
 - Nobles- warrior class, landowners, employed serfs and slaves
 - Priests- promised fertility, demanded human sacrifices
 - Vast trade networks
 - **Mayans** settled the Yucatan peninsula and rainforests (present day Guatemala)
 - Large cities with elaborate water storage systems
 - Built large palaces for the Gods
 - Learned mathematics, astronomy, hieroglyphics, and calendars
 - Began to decline around 800 A.D.
 - Likely the result of drought and heavy taxation
 - Began trading with the Aztecs
 - The **Incas** settled in the Andes Mountains
 - Had extensive road and garrison systems
 - Fertile mountain valleys allowed for crops
 - Gold, silver, and irrigation systems
 - Human sacrifice to keep natural disasters and military defeat away
