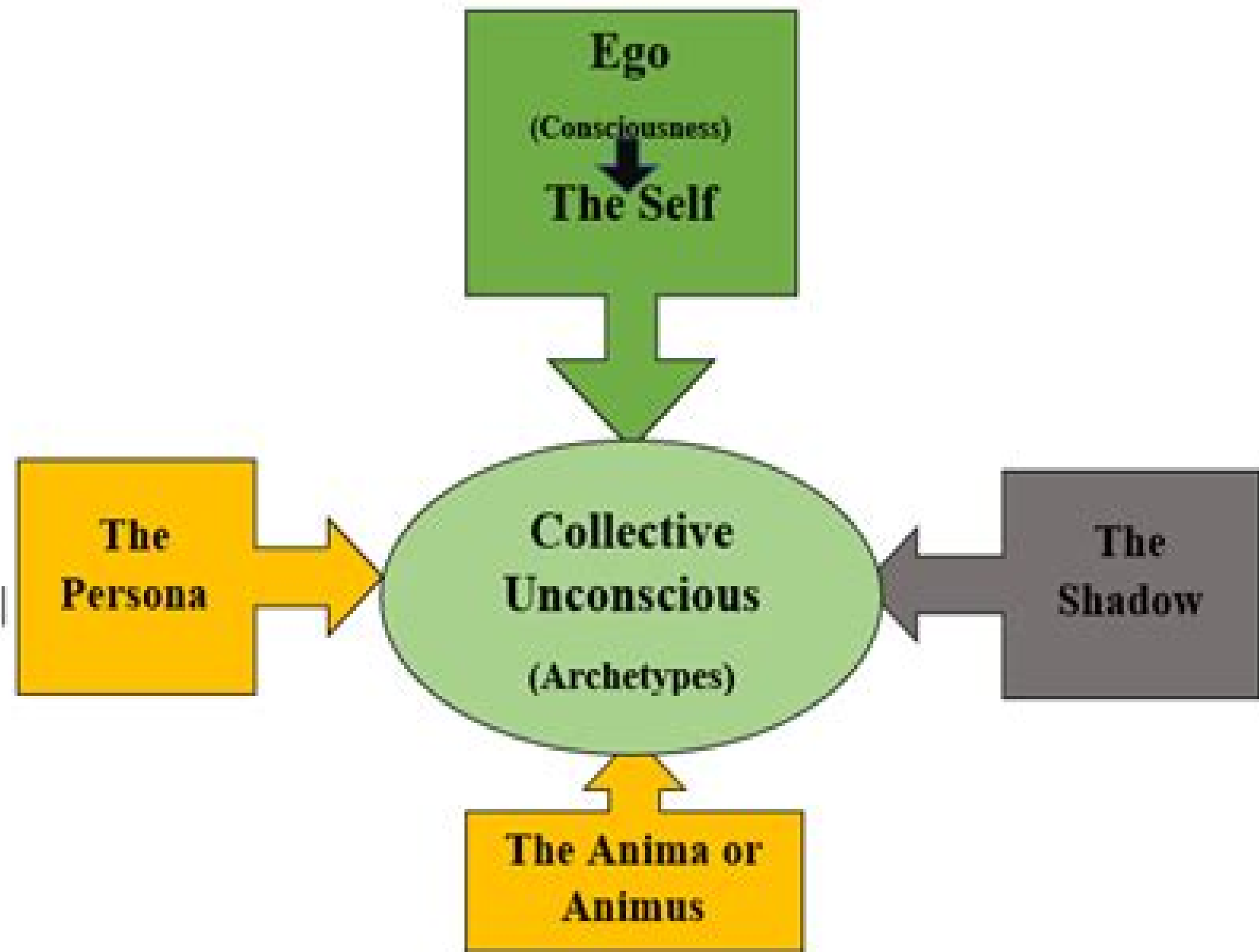

concept of implicit mythology This book also studies the Dalit language as a special case and unfolds various meanings about the culture community and people in context An important finding is that the language of marginalization is very much a reality Bama s narratives are true representations of the journey of the Parayar Dalit identity formation and the changes it has undergone over time The study of the different aspects of the lives ideologies and culture of the marginalized section of Indian society as represented by these writers in their works has enhanced the understanding of their significant role and contribution to Indian society which may not have over time been acknowledged yet undeniably needs to be appreciated and celebrated

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
