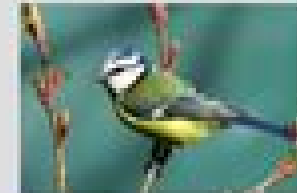

A Review of Aristotle's System of Ethics Edward Meredith Cope, 1867 **Aristotle's Modal Logic** Richard Patterson, 2002-08-22 Aristotle's Modal Logic first published in 1995 presents an interpretation of Aristotle's logic by arguing that a proper understanding of the system depends on an appreciation of its connection to the metaphysics. Richard Patterson develops three striking theses in the book. First, there is a fundamental connection between Aristotle's logic of possibility and necessity and his metaphysics, and that this connection extends far beyond the widely recognised tie to scientific demonstration and relates to the more basic distinction between the essential and accidental properties of a subject. Second, Aristotle's views on modal logic depend in very significant ways on his metaphysics without entailing any sacrifice in rigour. Third, once one has grasped the nature of the relationship, one can understand better certain genuine difficulties in the system of logic and appreciate its strengths in terms of the purposes for which it was created. **Medieval Modal Systems**

Paul Thom, 2017-09-08 This book explores noteworthy approaches to modal syllogistic adopted by medieval logicians including Abelard, Albert the Great, Avicenna, Averroes, Jean Buridan, Richard Campsall, Robert Kilwardby, and William of Ockham. The book situates these approaches in relation to Aristotle's discussion in the Prior and Posterior Analytics and other parts of the Organon, but also in relation to the thought of Alexander of Aphrodisias and Boethius on the one hand, and to modern interpretations of the modal syllogistic on the other. Problems explored include Aristotle's doctrine of modal conversion, the pure and mixed necessity moods, modal ecthesis, the pure and mixed contingency moods, and Aristotle's use of counter-examples. Medieval logicians brought various concepts to bear on these problems, including the distinction between *per se* and *per accidens* terms, the notion of essential predication, the distinction between *ut nunc* and *simpliciter* propositions, the distinction between *de dicto* and *de re* modals, and the notion of ampliation. All these are examined in this book.

Aristotle's Physics and Its Medieval Varieties Helen S. Lang, 1992-01-01 This book considers the concepts that lay at the heart of natural philosophy and physics from the time of Aristotle until the fourteenth century. The first part presents Aristotelian ideas, and the second part presents the interpretation of these ideas by Philoponus, Albertus Magnus, Thomas Aquinas, John Buridan, and Duns Scotus. Across the eight chapters, the problems and texts from Aristotle that set the stage for European natural philosophy as it was practiced from the thirteenth to the seventeenth centuries are considered first as they appear in Aristotle and then as they are reconsidered in the context of later interests. The study concludes with an anticipation of Newton and the sense in which Aristotle's physics had been transformed. Aristotle's Voice Jasper Neel, 2013-11-14 In this book Jasper Neel's sure to be controversial resituating of Aristotle centers around three questions that have been constants in his twenty-two years of teaching experience What does it mean to teach writing What should one know before teaching writing And if there is such a thing as research in the teaching of writing what is it Believing that all composition teachers are situated politically and socially both as part of the institution in which they teach and as beings with lived histories Neel examines his own life and the life of composition studies as a discipline in the context of Aristotle Neel first situates the Rhetoric as a political document he then situates the Rhetoric in the Aristotelian system and describes how professional discourse came to know itself through Aristotle's way of studying the world finally he examines the operation of the Rhetoric inside itself before arguing the need to turn to Aristotle's notion of sophistry as a way of negating his system By pointing out the connections among Aristotelian rhetoric the contemporary university and the contemporary writing teacher Neel shows that Aristotle's frightening social theories are as alive today as are Aristotelian notions of discourse Neel explains that by their very nature teachers must speak with a professional voice It is through showing how to hear one's professional voice that Neel explores the notion of professional discourse that originates with Aristotle In maintaining that one must pay a high price in order to speak through Aristotle's theory or to assume the role of professional he argues that no neutral ground exists either for pedagogy or for the analysis of pedagogy Neel concludes this discussion by proposing that Aristotelian sophistry is both an antidote to Aristotelian racism sexism and bigotry and a way of allowing Aristotelian categories of discourse to remain useful Finally as an Aristotelian a teacher and a writer Neel responds both to Aristotle and to professionalism by rethinking the influence of the past and reviving the voice of Aristotelian sophistry

Aristotle's Modal Proofs Adriane Rini, 2010-12-13 Aristotle's modal syllogistic is his study of patterns of reasoning about necessity and possibility Many scholars think the

modal syllogistic is incoherent a realm of darkness Others think it is coherent but devise complicated formal modellings to mimic Aristotle's results This volume provides a simple interpretation of Aristotle's modal syllogistic using standard predicate logic Rini distinguishes between red terms such as horse plant or man which name things in virtue of features those things must have and green terms such as moving which name things in virtue of their non necessary features By applying this distinction to the Prior Analytics Rini shows how traditional interpretive puzzles about the modal syllogistic melt away and the simple structure of Aristotle's own proofs is revealed The result is an applied logic which provides needed links between Aristotle's views of science and logical demonstration The volume is particularly valuable to researchers and students of the history of logic Aristotle's theory of modality and the philosophy of logic in general
