John Varley British Watercolour Series:

Great British Watercolors Matthew Hargraves, 2007-01-01 Paul Mellon 1907 1999 assembled one of the world's greatest collections of British drawings and watercolors. In his memoirs he wrote of their beauty and freshness, their immediacy and sureness of technique, their comprehensiveness of subject matter, their vital qualities, their Englishness. This catalogue celebrating the centenary of Mellon's birth features eighty-eight outstanding watercolors from the fifty thousand works of art on paper with which he endowed the Yale Center for British Art. The selection spans the emergence of watercolor painting in the mid 18th century to its apogee in the mid 19th. These works highlight the diversity of British watercolors, showcasing both landscape and figurative works by some of the principal artists working in the medium, including Thomas Gainsborough, Thomas Rowlandson, William Blake, and J. M. W. Turner.

The Business of Watercolour Simon Fenwick, Greg Smith, 2018-12-17 First published in 1997, this volume will revolutionise the study of watercolour painting in Britain. The Royal Watercolour Society archive constitutes a major academic resource covering two hundred years of the history of watercolour painting in Britain. The rediscovery in 1980 of the Jenkins Papers, the early records of the Society, was a major find for the history of British art. The archives are substantial and remarkably comprehensive. Minutes of annual general meetings, Council, and committees are all intact. Extraordinarily, the Society's catalogues for its own exhibitions have also survived, with details of who bought the pictures and for how much. It contains biographical information on several hundred artists who practised throughout the United Kingdom from the end of the eighteenth century to the present day. Prepared by the archivist to the RWS, Simon Fenwick, this is not just a work of reference but an absorbing book to dip into again and again. The Society of Painters in Water Colours, as it was then titled, was founded in 1804 to promote the interests of painters using watercolour and to provide a platform for members to sell their work. As such, its archives provide an excellent insight into the evolving debate on the status of the artists and their medium and an authoritative account of the way in which watercolour paintings were sold, distributed, and acquired. The substantial introduction by Greg Smith surveys some of the purposes and practices of watercolour from 1750 to the present day and highlights key issues many yet to be examined relating to the study of watercolour. His survey is arranged around a number of topics, including the notion of watercolour as a British art, collecting and display, book illustration, architectural drawing, map making, and topography, antiquarian studies, decorative arts, printmaking, portrait miniatures, and drawings, amateur practices, and the changing status of the sketch.

Sha,2016-11-11 With their broken lines and hasty brushwork sketches acquired enormous ideological and aesthetic power during the Romantic period in England Whether publicly displayed or serving as the basis of a written genre these rough drawings played a central role in the cultural ferment of the age by persuading audiences that less is more The Visual and Verbal Sketch in British Romanticism investigates the varied implications of sketching in late eighteenth and early nineteenth century culture Calling on a wide range of literary and visual genres Richard C Sha examines the shifting economic and aesthetic value of the sketch in sources ranging from auction catalogs and sketching manuals to novels that employed scenes of sketching and courtship He especially shows how sketching became a double edged accomplishment for women when used to define proper femininity Sha s work offers fresh readings of Austen Gilpin Wordsworth and Byron as well as less familiar writers and provides sophisticated interpretations of visual sketches As the first full length work about sketching during the Romantic era this volume is a rich interdisciplinary study of both representation and gender **Common Land**

in English Painting, 1700-1850 Ian Waites, 2012 An examination of the treatment of common land in the work of English painters at a time when much of it was to disappear forever A most elegantly written book that calmly knocked many entrenched but erroneous notions about British landscape painting firmly on the head Longlisted and commended by the judges of the 2013 William M B Berger prize for British art history During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries much of England's common land was eradicated by the processes of parliamentary enclosure However despite the fact that the landscape was frequently viewed as unproductive outmoded and unsightly many British landscape painters of the time including Constable Gainsborough and Turner resolutely continued to depict it This book is the first full study of how they did so using evidence drawn not only from art historical picture analysis but from contemporary poems and novels and the contemporary pamphlets essays and reports that advanced the rhetoric of both agricultural improvement and new theories on landscape aesthetics It highlights a deep rooted social and cultural attachment to the common field landscape and demonstrates that common land played a significant but until now underestimated role in both the history of English art and of the formation of an English national identity reflecting what are still highly sensitive issues of progress nostalgia and loss within the English countryside Recasting common land as a recurrent facet of English culture in the modern period the numerous paintings drawings and prints featured in this book give the reader a comprehensive and evocative sense of what this now almost wholly lost landscape looked like in its heyday Ian Waites is Senior Lecturer in History of Art and Design at the University of Lincoln

American Drawings and Watercolors in the Metropolitan Museum of Art Kevin J. Avery, Metropolitan Museum of Art (New York, N.Y.), 2002 The Metropolitan Museum began acquiring American drawings and watercolors in 1880 just ten years after its founding Since then it has amassed more than 1 500 works executed by American artists during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries in watercolor pastel chalk ink graphite gouache and charcoal This volume documents the draftsmanship of more than 150 known artists before 1835 and that of about 60 unidentified artists of the period It includes drawings and watercolors by such American masters as John Singleton Copley John Trumbull John Vanderlyn Thomas Cole Asher Brown Durand George Inness and James Abbott McNeill Whistler Because the 504 works illustrate such a wide range of media techniques and styles this publication is a veritable history of American drawing from the eighteenth through most of the nineteenth century Metropolitan Museum of Art website
