**The Grass Roots of English History** David Hey, 2016-05-05 In medieval and early modern Britain, people would refer to their local district as their country, a term now largely forgotten but still used up until the First World War. Core groups of families that remained rooted in these countries often bearing distinctive surnames still in use today shaped local culture and passed on their traditions. In *The Grass Roots of English History*, David Hey examines the differing nature of the various local societies that were found throughout England in these periods. The book provides an update on the progress that has been made in recent years in our understanding of the history of ordinary people living in different types of local societies throughout England and demonstrates the value of studying the varied landscapes of England from towns to villages, farmsteads, fields and woods to highways and lanes and historic buildings from cathedrals to cottages. With its broad coverage from the medieval period up to the Industrial Revolution, the book shows how England's socio-economic landscape had changed over time, employing evidence provided by archaeology, architecture, botany, cultural studies, linguistics and historical demography. *The Grass Roots of English History* provides an up-to-date account of the present state of knowledge about ordinary people in local societies throughout England, written by an authority in the field and as such will be of great value to all scholars of local and family history.

*Before & After Great Bardfield - The Artistic Memoirs of Lucie Aldridge*: Lucie Aldridge, Robjn Cantus, 2021-08-09 It will have to wait until I'm dead or Laura will shoot me. Lucie Aldridge wrote of her autobiography referring to Robert Graves's long-term mistress and muse, Laura Riding. A painter and rug weaver, Lucie Aldridge settled in the Essex village of Great Bardfield in 1933 with her husband, the painter John Aldridge. Also living there at that time were Eric Ravilious and his wife Tirzah Garwood, who were cohabiting with Charlotte and Edward Bawden. When Tirzah and John had an affair, it tarnished the Aldridge's marriage forever. Something Garwood didn't acknowledge in her biography *Long Live Great Bardfield*. This is Lucie's newly discovered autobiography with a detailed biographical postscript by Robjn Cantus. The memoirs were written at the suggestion of the editor of *Time* magazine, T. S. Matthews. They describe her unorthodox childhood in Cambridgeshire, the involvement of her family in Women's Suffrage, her marriage during the First World War and her experiences at Art School in London in the 1920s. A beautiful woman, she posed for several artists. She also observed the post-war era of the Bright Young Things and the painters she knew, including Robert Bevan, Cedric Morris and Stanley Spencer. Through John Aldridge, she came to know Robert Graves when he was living in Dei with Riding and provides a fascinating account of her visits there while Graves was in self-imposed exile after writing *Goodbye to All That*. During these visits, she also met and wrote about poets and artists such as Norman Cameron and Len Lye.

Lucie's memoir is illustrated by Edward Bawden. After Lucie's death in 1974 the memoir was lost but it recently surfaced in an American university archive. This is its first publication with Lucie's text illustrated with linocuts by Edward Bawden. The postscript covers the other artists of Great Bardfield and their friends. **Office**, 1997. **Suffolk in the Middle Ages** Norman Scarfe, 2007. Norman Scarfe explores place names, the Sutton Hoo ship burial, the coming of Christianity and the abbey at Bury St Edmunds, concluding with an evocative study of five Suffolk places: Southwold, Dunwich, Yoxford and Wingfield and Fressingfield. The modern landscape of Suffolk is still essentially a medieval one, though much of it is even earlier: the five hundred medieval churches and ten thousand listed houses of historic or architectural interest and the Hundred lanes going back at least to the tenth century are often found to be set in a landscape created before the Roman conquest. *Suffolk in the Middle Ages* opens with a discussion of the earliest written records of the place names as a guide to settlement patterns, including the setting of Sutton Hoo. Among the grave goods found in that celebrated ship and discussed here was the whetstone sceptre, asked to carry it from its showcase in the British Museum to the laboratory, the author acknowledges a closer feeling of involvement even than helping to re-open the ship in its mound in 1966. His explanation of the presence of the whetstone sceptre, printed here, has never been challenged. The

identification of a carved Anglo Saxon cross at Iken in 1977 prompted the essay here on St Botolph and the coming of East Anglian Christianity This leads to a consideration of the Danish invasion of East Anglia and a reexamination of the posthumous victory of King Edmund and Christianity as portrayed in an imaginary Breckland warren on the front of this book Scarfe s carefully reasoned argument that the Metropolitan Museum s famous walrusivory cross was made for the monks choir at Bury has never been refuted Life in Bury abbey is vividly reconstructed it was the most richly documented flowering of the work of East Anglia s apostles Felix and Fursa which also led to the phenomenal establishment in Suffolk by 1086 of four hundred of the five hundred medieval churches In four East Suffolk essays Southwold Dunwich Yoxford and Wingfield are exposed to Norman Scarfe s interpretative skills He reveals a past few could have guessed at often quite as curious as the Two Strange Tales unravelled in his concluding pages      *Country Fair* ,1969      *Bulletin* Salem Public Library,1895

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
