Sotiriou, 2019-03-28 Eurasia has long been characterized by intense competition among populations and among States The collapse of the Soviet Union constituted a critical juncture in the region's course since informal and formal norms subsided giving rise to a hardly regulated socio political environment where survival and security considerations ranked atop In this context populations first and foremost sought to have their existence guaranteed within nation states While in most cases that transition was accomplished without major impediments in the cases of Moldova Ukraine Georgia and Azerbaijan major challenges have been encountered leaving their mark deep in the post soviet course of the newly independent republics Moldova has been rattled by the conflict in Transdnistria Ukraine by the conflict in Crimea Georgia by the conflict in South Ossetia and Abkhazia and Azerbaijan by the conflict in Nagorno Karabakh In fact these conflicts have been classified as frozen conflicts given their unsettled nature and the smoldering fire between opposing populations within the respective republics This intense competition however has not been constrained only to the domestic level and only to the issue of frozen conflicts Eurasia's energy prospects have also been the cause of a constant power struggle among the States of the region With the Caspian Sea to constitute a rich in natural resources hub a clash of interests has taken place among the littoral States Moreover this competition has acquired a much broader geopolitical dimension extending to Eurasia's two ends the European Union and China As a result Eurasia's underbelly has become an area where the maximization of power figures as the best guarantee of survival and security in a fully unregulated environment Taken together frozen conflicts domestic level and energy politics international level stand out as the two main features of Eurasia both unfolding in comparable conditions Therefore the book presents them as a two level game aiming at offering better substantiated explanations that draw on the very fundamentals of political science and at building a bridge of communication between the two levels that allows for well informed and widely applicable policy implications

The First Atomic Bomb Jim Mangi,2022-06-20 While German and Japanese scientists also labored unsuccessfully to create an atomic bomb by the summer of 1945 the American led team was ready to test its first weapon As the clock ticked down to the detonation time of 05 30 hours on 16 July 1945 the nervous team of technicians and scientists waited ten miles away from Ground Zero deep in the New Mexico desert No one knew how powerful the explosion would be or whether even at such a distance they would be safe from the blast Even so some chose to observe the detonation from a point four miles nearer at the control bunker but then no one was even sure that the bomb would work What if that is actually what happened Under schedule pressure from the White House the scientists assembled the device in part with tape and tissue paper knowing some components were flawed These are verifiable facts It means that as many of those who gathered in the New Mexico desert feared at the time the bomb might not have worked during that first test In The First Atomic Bomb Jim Mangi explores what might happened in the event that the world s first atomic bomb had not been ready for use when it was How would this have affected the end of the war in the Pacific and indeed the Second World War as a whole Would Emperor Hirohito s armed forces have battled on When might Colonel Paul W Tibbets at the controls of his Boeing B 29 Superfortress Enola Gay have then made his historic flight over Hiroshima and would that city even have remained the target How would Stalin and the Soviets have reacted to such developments and how would this have played out in the post war world

Women's Work Jennifer Moore,2025-03-11 When women have full socioeconomic citizenship as well as equitable and respectful partnerships with

men transformative justice can be sustained in postconflict societies In Women s Work Jennifer Moore presents a reimagined theory of peacebuilding and transformative justice based on the experiences and insights of women farmers and microentrepreneurs who lived through protracted civil conflicts drawing on seven years of interviews with women activists across ten communities five in the Acholi region of Northern Uganda and five in the Moyamba and Koinadugu Districts of Sierra Leone Despite the important differences between the preconflict and conflict histories and demographics of the two countries Moore finds commonalities in the practical yet visionary approaches to community life emerging from the core values daily activities and long range goals shared by rural cooperative members in both regions Collective survival communal healing and conflict resolution define the rhythm of these women s daily lives as they go about building peace piecemeal They reject punitive retribution models and demand instead a peacebuilding model that advocates for advances in material well being the acknowledgment of state accountability for community suffering and reconciliation and restoration of community networks But most important Moore amplifies these women s voices when they insist that legal equality for women and healthy partnerships between women and men are also essential components to enduring transformation of their societies Moore theorizes what peacebuilding look like if it were modeled on these women led matriarchically structured communities that proved not only to be effective at holding governments accountable but also to have the capacity to feed their people and revitalize their local economies Women s Work shows that when women have full socioeconomic citizenship as well as equitable and respectful partnerships with men transformative justice can be sustained through the arts of collective livelihood violence free conflict management and celebration

The Glory Down William Lynwood Montell, 2014-10-17 In *Singing the Glory Down* William Lynwood Montell contributes to a fuller understanding of twentieth century American culture by examining the complex relationships between gospel music and the culture of the nineteen county study area in which this music has flourished for a hundred years. He has recorded the memories and feelings of those who were young while the movement gathered steam and who remember it at its high point and stories about those who have passed over that river about which they loved to sing. In the early 1900s a singing school or gospel convention was a major social event that enticed people to walk for miles to learn to sing or to hear someone who already had. The shape note teachers of those days conducted days or even weeks of nightly practice which culminated in a performance that confirmed the teacher's skill. Quartet music originated in these settings. Today some area quartets still sound much like those early groups; others teach themselves to sing by imitating their favorite professional gospel ensembles. They travel every weekend in buses emblazoned with the names of their groups with tapes and albums to sell. Through all the changes the four part southern harmony of Kentucky gospel music has remained the same. In the words of these performers through letters, diaries and interviews Montell details the attitudes and joys of those involved most deeply in the gospel music scene. He also brings the reader into their personal relationships, their professional jealousies and their struggles to keep alive the music they love.

US Economic Aid in Egypt Dina Jadallah, 2016-01-27 Economic aid is one of the cornerstones of the Egyptian American relationship and plays a significant role in promoting US policy objectives in the Middle East. Focusing on the latter half of Hosni Mubarak's rule, Dina Jadallah argues that through its aid policy the US has attempted to use a reforming and democratising narrative to transform Egypt into a stable market democracy that would be aligned with US interests in the region.
