Представлены основные современные направления инучения ципофрении с ведущей негативной симитомативной в клинической вариние. Преимущественно рассмотрены работы, валиощнеся регультатами оригинальных исследований, в также проблемные публикации по вопросам клинической динамини, изучения комституциональных закономерностей, адаптации и терапии ципофрении с преобладающей истативной симитомативой. Помазан междусциплинарный характер обсуждаемой проблемы, лежащей в изоскости биогекскосоциального подхода. Продемонстрирован приоритет уточнения феноменология клинических паттерном и динамики шизофрении с преобладанием встативной симитомативки в связи с предстоящим переходом на новый пересмотр Международной классификации боление, а также необходимость утлублениых исследований клинини конституциональных факторов на клиническую динамику и протиоз заболевания в аспекте адаптации больных и проводимой терапии.

Воедение

Изучение шизофрении в настоящее время остается одной из наиболее актуальных проблем клинической пенхнатрии [29]. Это обусловлено радом не решенных до сих пор вопросов, касающихся ее типологии [28], клиники [75], терапии [1]. Все более часто шизофрения рассматривается с позиции биопеихосощиального подхода [43], который в последние годы заиял ведущее место во многих исследованиях в психиатрии [4, 59].

Являясь хроническим прогреднентным заболеванием, пинофрения часто приводит к нетрудоспособности [20], что определяет высокие затраты общества не только на се непосредственное лечение [25], но и на социальную защиту, поддержку и реабилитацию больных [50]. Несмотря на появление новых поколений антипсикотических препаратов, число выздоровлений и длительных ремяесий практически не увеличивается [8], а комплекс пробоюм, связанный с нежелательными явлениями веледствие лекарственного лечения, не уменьшается [51].

Одним из ключевых аспектов прогноза шизофрении является возможность влияния реабилитации на изменения в личностной сфере, затрагивающие эмопиональные [37], воленые [57] и ассоциативные пропессы [2], а также социальное функционирование [54]. Будучи основой негативного синдрома [70], эти изменения являются наиболее трудно курируемыми и ложатся тяжелым бременем на самого больного [62], его семью [23], здравоохранение [47] и социальные службы [76]. Шизофрения с преобладанием негативной симптоматики в клинической картине в настоящее время выступает объектом большого количества исследований [61], в частности, широко представлены в современной специальной литературе публикации. посвященные изучению молекулярно-генетических закономерностей [34], психонейронммунологии [58], нейровизуализации [3], проблем нейрокогнитивного дефицита [26], фармакологического [64] и нелекарственного [27] лечения, а также реабилитации [19]. Выссте с тем значительно сократилось число работ, посвященных клинической динамике негативной сим-
