Chris Westgate, 2009-05-05 Not long after the 2001 terrorist attacks in New York City Bertolt Brecht's name was on the lips of many writing about Broadway Invoked knowingly but not always knowledgeably Brecht became something between marketing strategy and erudite justification for another season of Broadway musicals another ignominy endured by the German playwright whose epic theater has only seldom been understood in the United States To say that Brechtian and Broadway theatrical traditions represent divergence of philosophy method or ambition is to indulge with the whimsy of Mark Twain in understatement Nevertheless many references to Brecht since 2001 imply

American exponents were the Germans Marlene Dietrich and Lotte Lenya whose careers extended through the 1970s. Because of them and others the words and music of such artists as Kurt Weill, Bertolt Brecht, Friedrich Hollaender and Marcellus Schiffer continue to be heard and exert widespread influence. Major songwriters touched by cabaret include Lennon McCartney, Bacharach, David, Kander & Ebb, Bob Dylan, Randy Newman and Patti Smith among many others. African American artists beginning with Louis Armstrong have been sympathetic interpreters of cabaret music. Modern day Las Vegas appears to be the fulfillment of a prophecy made in the late 1920s by Weill & Brecht in their Mahagonny stage works. And today the German Kabarett tradition remains strong with such stars as Ute Lemper and Max Raabe packing international venues.

Gregory Divers examines poems by major figures in 20th century German literature: Benn, Brecht, Bachmann, Jandl and Grass among others and by other poets who shaped America's postwar image in Germany. Divers traces America's postwar status in Germany from the prisoner of war poems of G. nter Eich to the pop poetry of Rolf Dieter Brinkmann and Peter Handke. Continuing he finds that although the 1960s protest poems of Erich Fried and others reflect the tarnishing of America's image due to Vietnam, 1970s travel poems by Brinkmann, Kunert and Kunze confirm the resiliency of that image. Finally Divers looks at poems by Hartung, Delius and Kling to illustrate the new heights reached by America's image within German literary circles during the 1980s and the status of America in Germany after reunification. In charting these developments in postwar German poetry, Divers also shows how American influences are crucial to its understanding, not only surveying postwar German reception of Whitman, Eliot, Pound and William Carlos Williams but also examining the influence of such figures as Charles Olson and Robert Creeley, Allen Ginsberg and the Beats, Frank O'Hara and John Ashbery and Robert Lowell and Sylvia Plath.
