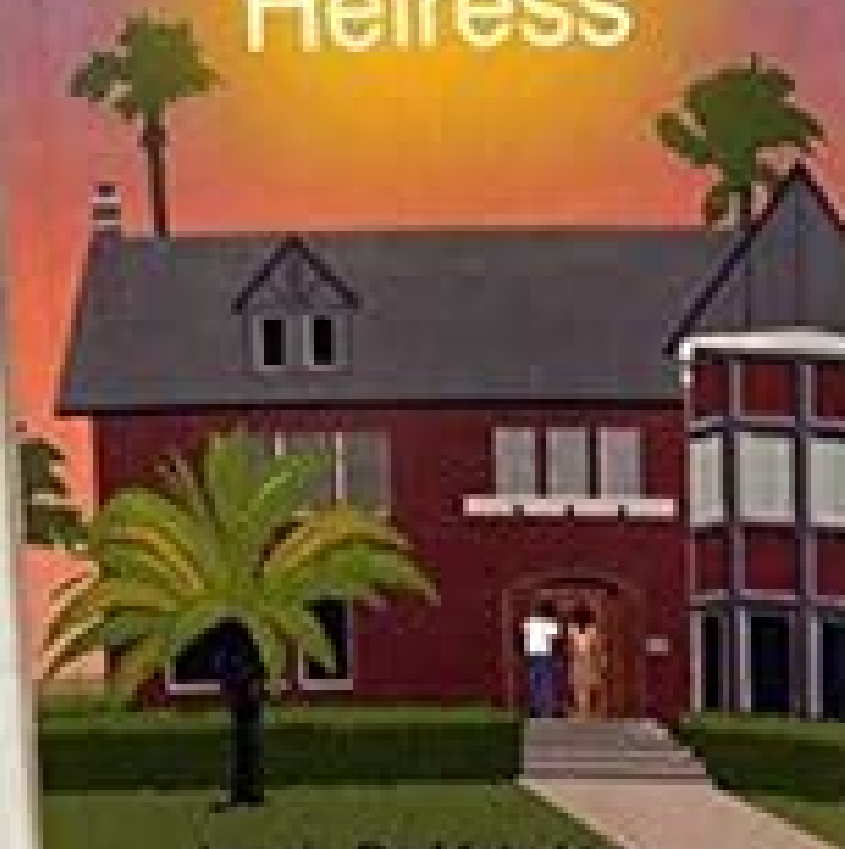

apartment Ewing created the Gallery of Extraordinary Portraits an installation of photos of his favorite celebrities Black and white clothed and nude For his Carnival of Venice he took portraits of more than a hundred friends including Paul Robeson Berenice Abbott Isamu Noguchi Agnes de Mille and E E Cummings posed in front of a backdrop of Saint Mark s Square Like a character from a story by F Scott Fitzgerald Ewing joined the party and then died tragically unable to accept the end of his era or the lost dream of a new way of living His story sheds new light on modernism and an artistic milieu that was ahead of its time
