If Tropes A-S. Maurin, 2013-04-17 In the book If Tropes the author attempts to approach and then deal with some of the most basic problems for a theory of tropes The investigation proceeds from three basic assumptions i tropes i e particular properties exist ii only tropes exist that is tropes are the only basic or fundamental kind of entities and iii the main function for tropes is to serve as truth makers for atomic propositions Provided that one accepts these assumptions the author finds that the trope theorist will have to deal with two important matters Some atomic propositions seem to require universal truth makers and others seem to require concrete truth makers This means that universals and concrete particulars will need to be constructed from the material of tropes Such constructions are attempted and it is argued that it is possible to deal at least with these basic issues while staying squarely within the boundaries of a purely trope theoretical framework The book is written in an untechnical language but requires some prior understanding of basic metaphysics

Ontology and Providence in Creation critically examines a particular Leibnizean inspired understanding of God's creation of the world and proposes that a different understanding should be adopted The Leibnizean argument proposes that God's understanding encompassed a host of possible worlds only one of which he actualized This proposition is the current orthodoxy when philosophers and theologians talk about the philosophical understanding of creation Mark Robson argues that this commits the Leibnizean to the notion that possibility is determinate He proposes that this understanding of creation does not do justice to the doctrine that God created the world out of nothing Instead of possible worlds Robson argues that we should understand possibility as indeterminate There are no things in possibility hence God created out of nothing He examines how this conception of possibility is held by C S Peirce and how it was developed by Charles Hartshorne Robson contends that not only does the indeterminate understanding of possibility take seriously the nothing of *ex nihilo* but that it also offers a new solution to the problem of evil **On the Elements of Ontology** D. Abstract Objects and the Semantics of Natural Language Friederike Moltmann, 2013-03-28 Abstract objects have been a central topic in philosophy since antiquity Philosophers have defended various views about abstract objects by appealing to metaphysical considerations considerations regarding mathematics or science and not infrequently intuitions about natural language This book pursues the question of how and whether natural language allows for reference to abstract objects in a fully systematic way By making full use of contemporary linguistic semantics it presents a much greater range of linguistic generalizations than has previously been taken into consideration in philosophical discussions and it argues for an ontological picture is very different from that generally taken for granted by philosophers and semanticists alike Reference to abstract objects such as properties numbers propositions and degrees is considerably more marginal than generally held Instead natural language is rather generous in allowing reference to particularized properties tropes the use of nonreferential expressions in apparent referential position and the use of nominalizing expressions such as quantifiers like something Reference to abstract objects is achieved generally only by the use of reifying terms such as the number eight

Works of Music Julian Dodd, 2007-02-22 In this original and iconoclastic book Julian Dodd argues for what he terms the simple view of the ontological nature of works of pure instrumental music This account is the conjunction of two theses the type token theory and sonicism The type token theory addresses the question of which ontological category musical works fall under and its answer is that such works are types whose tokens are sound sequence events Sonicism meanwhile addresses the question of how works of music are individuated and it tells us that works of music are identical just in case they sound exactly alike Both conjuncts of the simple view are highly controversial and Dodd defends them vigorously and with ingenuity Even though the simple view is favoured by very few writers in the philosophy of music Dodd maintains that it is the default position given our ordinary intuitions about musical works that it can answer the sorts of objections that have led other philosophers to dismiss it and that it is on reflection the most promising ontology of music on offer Specifically Dodd argues that the type token theory offers the best explanation of the repeatability of works of music the fact that such works admit of multiple occurrence Furthermore he goes on to claim that the theory's most striking consequence namely that musical works are eternal existents and hence that composers discover rather than create their works is minimally disruptive of our intuitions concerning the nature of composition and our
