December *Advances in Selected Plant Physiology Aspects* Giuseppe Montanaro, 2012-04-25 The book provides general principles and new insights of some plant physiology aspects covering abiotic stress plant water relations mineral nutrition and reproduction Plant response to reduced water availability and other abiotic stress e g metals have been analysed through changes in water absorption and transport mechanisms as well as by molecular and genetic approach A relatively new aspects of fruit nutrition are presented in order to provide the basis for the improvement of some fruit quality traits The involvement of hormones nutritional and proteomic plant profiles together with some structure function of sexual components have also been addressed Written by leading scientists from around the world it may serve as source of methods theories ideas and tools for students researchers and experts in that areas of plant physiology *Biology and biochemistry of host-pathogen interactions in marine brown algae* Frithjof Christian Küpper, 2020-10-13 Associations of marine algae with symbiotic or parasitic microorganisms are ubiquitous phenomena known for a long time However there is an almost complete lack of knowledge on details of such interactions The intention of this study is to use the potentials of modern biological and biochemical techniques in order to analyze the reaction of brown algal hosts to the attack by pathogens and epibionts A 3 year field study at different localities on the European Atlantic coast revealed that *Pylaiella littoralis* populations were subject to massive epidemics of the parasites *Eurychasma dicksonii* *Chytridium polysiphoniae* and *Anisolpidium rosenvingei* Laboratory cultures were used to investigate the association of *Eurychasma* and *Chytridium* with brown algal hosts from

different taxonomic groups Eurychasma has a much broader host range than Chytridium comprising members of all brown algal orders investigated and it tolerates a wider range of temperatures than the latter Phylogenetic studies based upon 18 S rRNA genes revealed that Eurychasma dicksonii belongs to the Oomycota branching at an ancestral position between terrestrial plant pathogens and free living members of the marine heterotrophic picoplankton Chytridium polysiphoniae a fungus appears more closely related to the genera Rhizophydium and Spizellomyces Chytridiomycota than to other known Chytridium species Chytridium produces chitin whilst Eurychasma does not Early stages of Eurychasma infection have a rather modest effect on host physiology The photosynthetic capacity is enhanced suggesting a temporary stimulation of host metabolism for hypertrophic growth Chytridium in contrast has an immediate detrimental effect on host photosynthesis which breaks down once a cell is infected leading to the rapid death of infected cells *Aquatic Plant Control Program* Richard W.
