McClure,2012 In 1941 the Japanese invaded the Philippines with overwhelming force and forced the surrender of American troops at Bataan and Corregidor Prisoners of war were subjected to brutal captivity and thousands did not survive This is the story of an American soldier who survived and became a hero When American troops liberated the Niigata POW camp after the Japanese surrender Corporal Joseph O Quintero greeted them with a homemade American flag that had been sewn together in secrecy The son of Mexican immigrants Joseph Quintero grew up in a converted railroad caboose in Fort Worth Texas and joined the Army to get 21 a month and three meals a day He manned a

machine gun in the defense of Corregidor before his unit was captured by the Japanese. When prisoners of war were transported to Japan, Joseph survived a razor blade appendectomy on the hell ship voyage. In the prison camp, he cared for his fellow prisoners as a medic and came to be known as Don Jose. Joseph's narrative is an enlisted man's view of the war with first-hand descriptions of conditions in the POW camps and personal glimpses of what he and his buddies did, endured, and talked about. The authors have drawn on other histories and official documents to put his story into perspective and focus on a little-known chapter of World War II.

US Army Paratrooper in the Pacific Theater 1943-45 Gordon L. Rottman, 2012-11-20. The two major Army units that operated in the Pacific, the 11th Airborne Division and the 503rd Parachute Regimental Combat Team (PRCT), launched small-scale operations on extremely difficult, if not outright dangerous terrain while also conducting amphibious assaults, fighting on jungled hills, swamps, and mud. The two units were very different, with the 503rd PRCT being reserved for special purpose missions and the 11th Airborne Division occupying a more traditional role. This title will deal with the background to these two units and their training before detailing the specific equipment used in the theatre and finally, and most importantly, the combat experience at a personal level of the US Army Paratrooper in the Pacific.

Given the focus on the Brigade Combat Team as the Army's primary combat unit, the limited availability of U.S. Air Force airlift assets, and the U.S. Army history of employing predominantly medium-sized airborne units, future airborne operations in support of operational level objectives will likely center around the Airborne Brigade Combat Team (ABCT). The combat airborne operations of the 503d Parachute Infantry Regiment will provide a case study to assess the elements of risk, surprise, and the operational context of how the airborne unit contributed to the achievement of the operational and strategic outcomes. The combat airborne operations discussed are the jump to retake the island of Corregidor in the Philippines in February 1945, Operation Junction City in February 1967, and the airborne insertion of the 173d Airborne Brigade onto the Bashur airfield in Northern Iraq in March 2003. The intent of this monograph is to provide insights into the possible employment of the current ABCT and how to best use the resources and organization that we have, not necessarily to advocate a radically new airborne organization, propose new equipment, or recommend a new mission for airborne forces.

Japanese Military Strategy in the Pacific War James B.

Wood, 2023-06-14. In this provocative history, James B. Wood challenges the received wisdom that Japan's defeat in the Pacific was historically inevitable. He argues instead that it was only when the Japanese military prematurely abandoned its original sound strategic plan to secure the resources Japan needed and establish a viable defensible perimeter for the Empire that the Allies were able to regain the initiative and lock Japanese forces into a war of attrition they were not prepared to fight. The book persuasively shows how the Japanese army and navy had both the opportunity and the capability to have fought a different and more successful war in the Pacific that could have influenced the course and outcome of World War II. It is

therefore a study both of Japanese defeat and of what was needed to achieve a potential Japanese victory or at the very least to avoid total ruin Wood's argument does not depend on signal individual historical events or dramatic accidents. Instead it examines how familiar events could have been different.

In this first full-length biography, Ann B. Irish explores Byrnes's life and career, detailing his achievements and assessing their impact. After serving in the Tennessee General Assembly from 1895 to 1901, Byrns was elected to Congress in 1909. He was involved in tariff issues, World War I expenditures, economic development of impoverished areas, and farm policy. As a longtime senior Democrat on the Appropriations Committee, he played a major role in creating the first budget system for the United States government. Ever responsive to the needs of his constituents, Byrns strove during the Depression years for two urgent but somewhat contradictory goals: a balanced budget and relief for the needy. In 1932, he was instrumental in defeating a proposed federal sales tax. During Franklin D. Roosevelt's first term, Byrns was House Majority Leader for two years, then Speaker. As a moderate southern Democrat, he privately questioned some of Roosevelt's programs but nevertheless embraced the New Deal out of party loyalty. He introduced the bill creating the Civilian Conservation Corps and successfully maneuvered other major
