Prohibition The author also shows that the years of illegal opium trade with China by American merchants served as precursor to the later smuggling of opium into the United States The author confirms that each period of smuggling was a link in the continuing chain of white collar crime in the 150 years prior to Sutherland's assertion of corporate criminality
