The Unemployed People's Movement James J. Lorence, 2011-03-01 In Georgia during the Great Depression jobless workers united with the urban poor sharecroppers and tenant farmers In a collective effort that cut across race and class boundaries they confronted an unresponsive political and social system and helped shape government policies James J Lorence adds significantly to our understanding of this movement which took place far from the northeastern and midwestern sites we commonly associate with Depression era labor struggles Drawing on extensive archival research including newly accessible records of the Communist Party of the United States Lorence details interactions between various institutional and grassroots players including organized labor the Communist Party the Socialist Party liberal activists and officials at every level of government He shows for example how the Communist Party played a more central role than previously understood in the organization of the unemployed and the advancement of labor and working class interests in Georgia Communists gained respect among the jobless especially African Americans for their willingness to challenge officials help negotiate the welfare bureaucracy and gain access to New Deal social programs Lorence enhances our understanding of the struggles of the poor and unemployed in a Depression era southern state At the same time we are reminded of their movement s lasting legacy the shift in popular consciousness that took place as Georgians influenced by a new sense of entitlement fostered by the unemployed organizations began to conceive of new more equal relations with the state

Rogers, John France, 2023-06-06 The leading academic vehicle for scholarly publication in the field of medieval warfare Medieval Warfare The twenty first volume of the Journal of Medieval Military History begins with three studies examining aspects of warfare in the Latin East an archaeological report on the defenses of Jerusalem by Shimon Gibson and Rafael Y Lewis a study of how military victories and defeats viewed through the lens of carefully shaped reporting affected the reputation and the flow of funds and recruits to the Military Orders by Nicolas Morton and an exploration of how the Kingdom of Jerusalem quickly recovered its military strength after the disaster of Hattin by Stephen Donnachie Turning to the other side of the Mediterranean Donald J Kagay analyzes how Jaime I of Aragon worked to control violence within his realms by limiting both castle construction and the use of mechanical artillery Guilhem P pin also addresses the limitation of violence using new documents to show that the Black Prince s sack of Limoges in 1370 was not the unrestrained bloodbath described by Froissart The remaining three contributions deal with aspects of open battle Michael John Harbinson offers a large scale study of when and why late medieval men at arms chose to dismount and fight on foot instead of acting tactically as cavalry Laurence W Marvin reconsiders the Battle of Bouvines concluding that it was far from being a ritualized mass duel Finally Michael Livingston elucidates some principles for understanding medieval battles in general and the battle of Agincourt in particular

Lorence, 2007 A Hard Journey brings to life Don West poet ordained Congregationalist minister labour organizer educator leftist radical activist and one of the most important literary and political figures in the southern Appalachians during the middle years of the twentieth century Motivated by religious conviction and driven by a vision of an open democratic and non racist society West was also a passionate advocate for the region s traditional values Rather than focus on his literary achievements alone James J Lorence s biography balances his literary work with political and educational activities placing West s poetry in the context of his fight for social justice and racial equality Uncovering the ethical and religious roots of West s militant antifascism Lorence uses previously unexamined sources to explore his early involvement in organizing miners and other workers for the Socialist and Communist Parties during the 1930s In detailing West s participation in the Communist Party
