

1. Why is there support for euthanasia?

“The numbers involved [with assisted dying] will be very low because with good palliative care, most suffering can be palliated. The hospice movement has been a fantastic success story and one which Christians are justly proud to have supported. But it does not meet all needs. Baroness Finlay, the leading palliative care specialist in Wales, has acknowledged that palliative care “does not get it right 100 per cent of the time”. Unfortunately, it is also the case that some patients find the whole dying process unbearable. We know this because new members of societies like Dignity in Dying give as their principal reason for joining that they have witnessed at first hand the suffering of a parent or spouse and they want the law changed so that others do not suffer in the same way. That is certainly my own motivation.”
