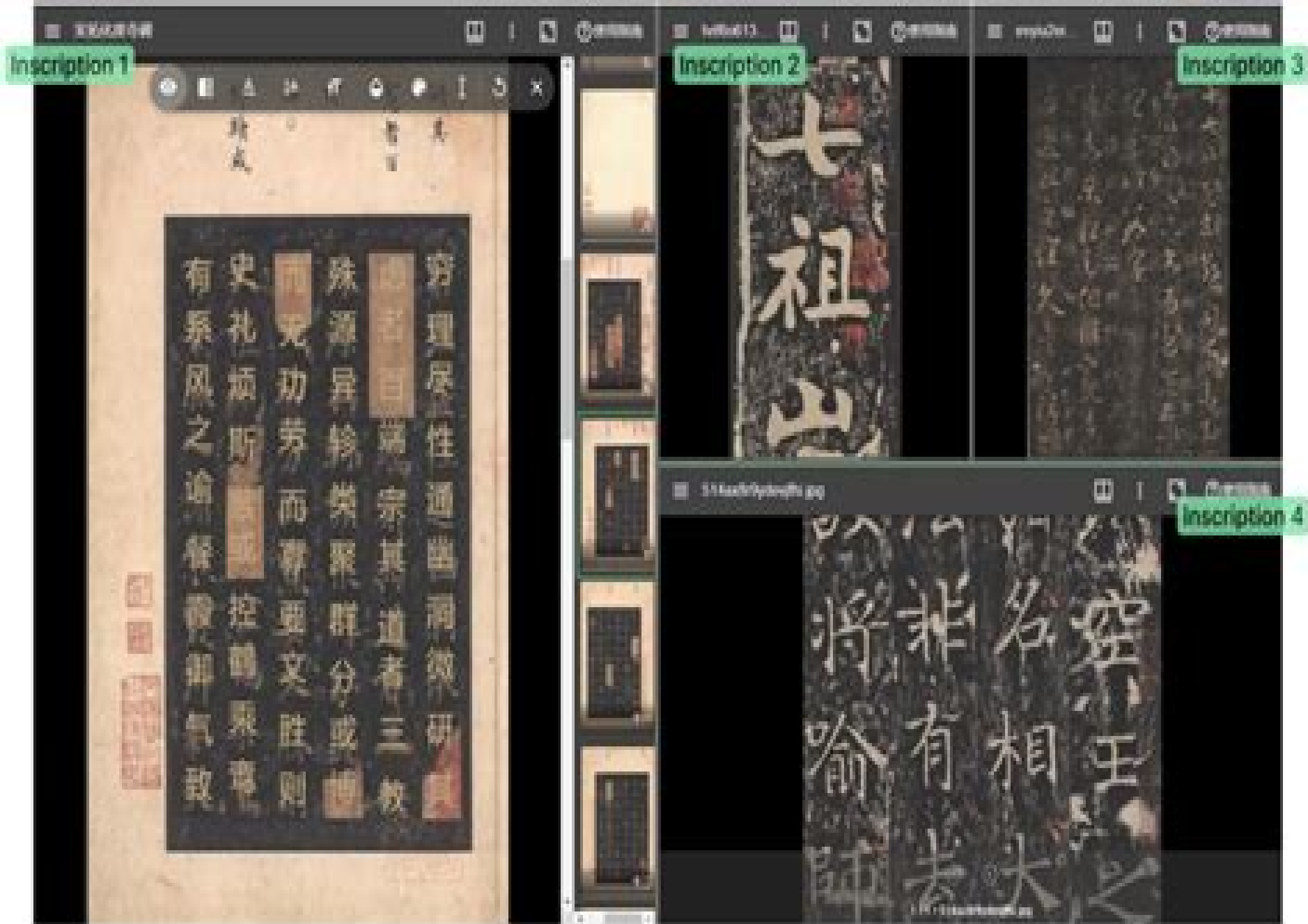

Eulogy for Burying a Crane and the Art of Chinese Calligraphy Lei Xue, 2019-12-06 Eulogy for Burying a Crane Yi he ming is perhaps the most eccentric piece in China's calligraphic canon Apparently marking the burial of a crane the large inscription datable to 514 CE was once carved into a cliff on Jiaoshan Island in the Yangzi River Since the discovery of its ruins in the early eleventh century it has fascinated generations of scholars and calligraphers and been enshrined as a calligraphic masterpiece Nonetheless skeptics have questioned the quality of the calligraphy and complained that its fragmentary state and worn characters make assessment of its artistic value impossible Moreover historians have trouble fitting it into the storyline of Chinese calligraphy Such controversies illuminate moments of discontinuity in the history of the art form that complicate the mechanism of canon formation In this volume Lei Xue examines previous epigraphic studies and recent archaeological finds to consider the origin

of the work in the sixth century and then trace its history after the eleventh century He suggests that formation of the canon of Chinese calligraphy over two millennia has been an ongoing process embedded in the sociopolitical realities of particular historical moments This biography of the stone monument Eulogy for Burying a Crane reveals Chinese calligraphy to be a contested field of cultural and political forces that have constantly reconfigured the practice theory and historiography of this unique art form Art History Publication Initiative A McLellan Book **A General History of Chinese Art** Xifan

Wong, 2004-09-30 Buddhist steles represent an important subset of early Chinese Buddhist art that flourished during the Northern and Southern Dynasties period 386-581. More than two hundred Chinese Buddhist steles are known to have survived. Their brilliant imagery has long captivated scholars, yet until now the Buddhist stele as a unique art form has received little scholarly attention. Dorothy Wong rectifies that insufficiency by providing in this well-illustrated volume the first comprehensive investigation of this group of Buddhist monuments. She traces the ancient roots of the Chinese stele tradition and investigates the process by which Chinese steles were adapted for Buddhist use. She arranges the known corpus of Buddhist steles into broad chronological and regional groupings and analyzes not only their form and content but also the nexus of complex issues surrounding this art form: from cultural symbolism to the interrelations between religious doctrine and artistic expression, economic production, patronage, and the synthesis of native and foreign art styles. In her analysis of Buddhism's dialogue with native traditions, Wong demonstrates how the Chinese artistic idiom planted the seeds for major achievements in figural and landscape arts in the ensuing Sui and Tang periods.

Protecting the Dharma through Calligraphy in Tang China Pietro De Laurentis, 2021-11-29 This is a study of the earliest and finest collated inscription in the history of Chinese calligraphy: the Ji Wang shengjiao xu Preface to the Sacred Teaching Scriptures Translated by Xuanzang in Wang Xizhi's Collated Characters, which was erected on January 1, 673. The stele records the two texts written by the Tang emperors Taizong (599-649) and Gaozong (628-683) in honor of the monk Xuanzang (d. 664) and the Buddhist scripture Xin jing Heart Sutra collated in the semi-cursive characters of the great master of Chinese calligraphy Wang Xizhi (303-361). It is thus a Buddhist inscription that combines Buddhist authority, political power, and artistic charm in one single monument. The present book reconstructs the multifaceted context in which the stele was devised, aiming at highlighting the specific role calligraphy played in the propagation and protection of Buddhism in medieval China.

Fu Shan's World Qianshen Bai, 2020-03-23 For 1,300 years Chinese calligraphy was based on the elegant art of Wang Xizhi (A.D. 303-361). But the seventeenth-century emergence of a style modeled on the rough, broken epigraphs of ancient bronzes and stone artifacts brought a revolution in calligraphic taste. By the eighteenth century this led to the formation of the stele school of calligraphy, which continues to shape Chinese calligraphy today. A dominant force in this school was the eminent calligrapher and art theorist Fu Shan (1607-1685). Because his work spans the late Ming-early Qing divide, it is an ideal prism through which to view the transformation in calligraphy. Rather than seek a single explanation for the change in calligraphic taste, the author demonstrates and analyzes the heterogeneity of the cultural, social, and political processes behind it. Among other subjects, the book covers the late Ming interaction between high and low culture, the role of publishing, the Ming loyalist response to the Qing, and early Qing changes in intellectual discourse. In addition to the usual approach of art historians, it adopts the theoretical perspectives of such fields as material culture, print culture, and social and intellectual history.

Black Tigers Kenneth Starr, 2018-02-06

Since at least the early sixth century C E ink rubbings of stone metal clay tiles and wood inscriptions and pictorial images have been used in China to make precise copies of culturally valued material These paper copies sometimes are all that remain of original works that have become illegible through erosion or that have been destroyed by war or development or have been rendered inaccessible through events such as flooding resulting from dam construction Chinese rubbing techniques are used throughout East Asia to create copies that often also are prized in themselves as works of art Despite the primary importance of this technology to history art archaeology printing and many other fields of knowledge *Black Tigers* is the first comprehensive study of rubbings in a Western language and as such will be welcomed by both scholars and collectors In *Black Tigers* Kenneth Starr recounts what he has seen and learned in fifty years of fascination with rubbings and travels to China in search of the early inscriptions from which they came The book is a history of rubbings a guide to connoisseurship and a technical handbook on the materials and techniques used to make rubbings Now readers of English with the author as their affable guide can gain rich insight into a rigorous discipline of classical scholarship the way in which traditional scholars viewed their world and some of the exquisite subtleties of Chinese high culture and connoisseurship *Black Tigers* will be an essential resource for students of Chinese art history calligraphy archaeology and the history of printing
