Gary Miller,2013-12-12 Epic is dialectally mixed but Ionic at its core The proper dialect for elegy was Ionic even when composed by Tyrtaeus in Sparta or Theognis in Megara both Doric areas Choral lyric poets represent the major dialect areas Aeolic Sappho Alcaeus Ionic Anacreon Archilochus Simonides and Doric Alcman Ibycus Stesichorus Pindar Most distinctive are the Aeolic poets The rest may have a preference for their own dialect some more than others but in their Lesbian veneer and mixture of Doric and Ionic forms are to some extent dialectally indistinguishable All of the ancient authors use a literary language that is artificial from the point of view of any individual dialect Homer has the most forms that occur in no actual dialect In this volume by means of dialectally and chronologically arranged illustrative texts translated and provided with running commentary some of the early Greek authors are compared against epigraphic records where available from the same period and locality in order to provide an appreciation of the
