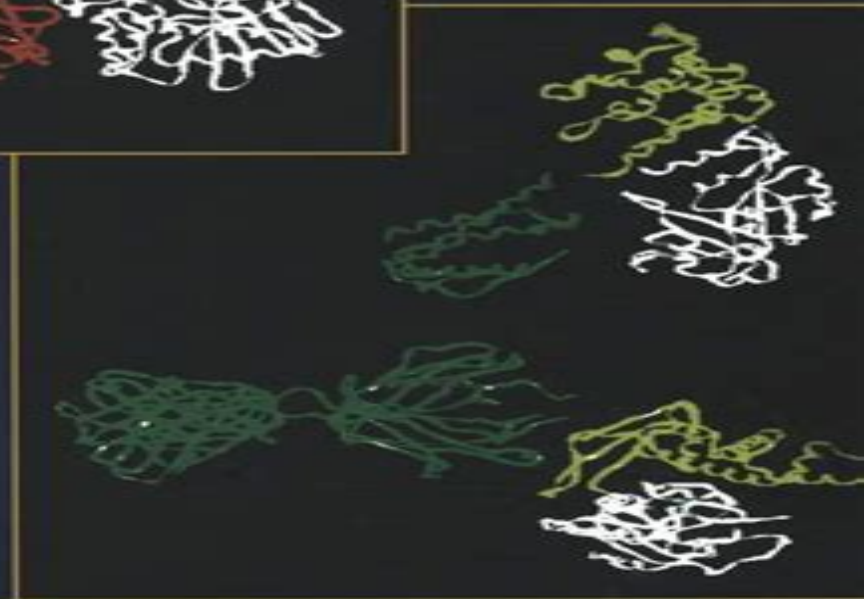
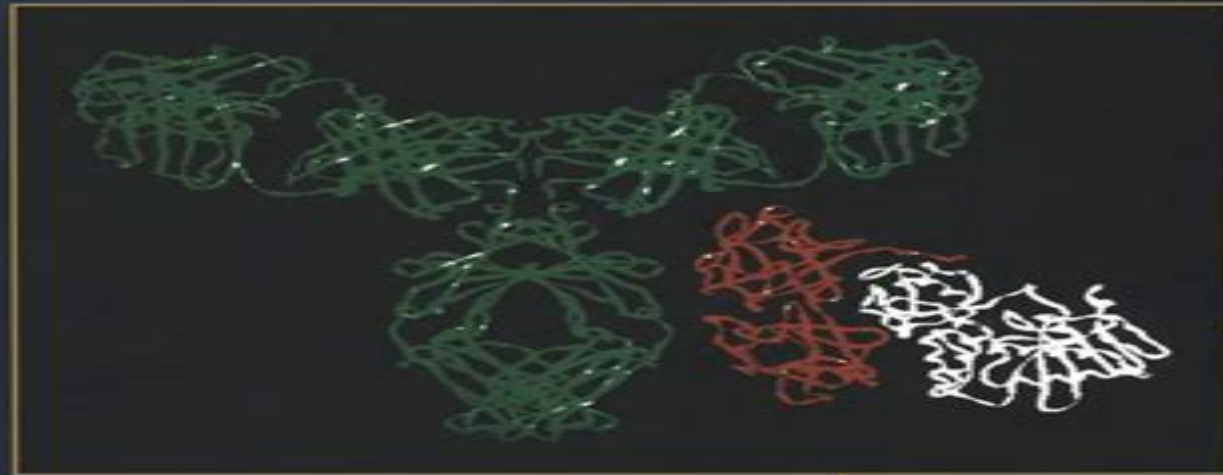


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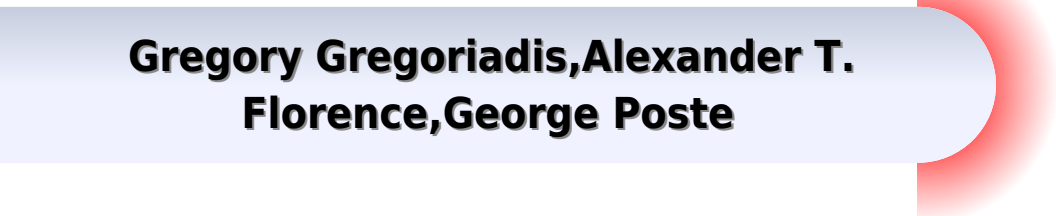

Introduction While various treatment approaches for cancer include reversal of the transformed phenotype stimulation of immune responses inhibition of metastatic spread and deprivation of key nutrients the goal of immunotoxin treatment is the direct killing of malignant cells Because they are enzymatic proteins that act catalytically to kill cells bacterial and plant toxins are often employed as the cell killing component of immunotoxins Here we provide background information into the structure function relationships of toxins and discuss how they can be combined with cell binding antibodies or other ligands to generate immunotoxins Bacterial and plant toxins e g diphtheria toxin Pseudomonas exotoxin and ricin are among the most toxic substances known However because they bind to cell surface receptors that are present on most normal cells unmodified toxins are generally useless as anti cancer agents To convert toxins into more selective agents their binding domains are either eliminated or disabled and replaced with cell binding antibodies that are tumor selective

Moore,2012-12-06 It has been almost 20 years since the discovery by Kohler and Milstein of the technology to produce monoclonal antibodies MAb a discovery that promised revolutionary changes in research clinical diagnosis and human therapy From today s perspective it is fair to conclude that this promise has been realized in two areas of the three As research tools MABs have been invaluable their ability to selectively bind and localize specific antigens detect and identify new ligands and their receptors and agonize and or antagonize specific molecular interactions continues to provide a useful and enabling technology to basic research endeavors Similarly MABs have demonstrated enormous practical impact as diagnostic tools Recent advances in clinical diagnostic medicine continue to rely heavily on the use of MAB based reagents for detecting and localizing antigens of clinical import In contrast however MABs have not proven to have major impact on human disease therapy With the single exception of an immunosup pressive MAB against the T cell antigen CD3 MABs have as yet found few meaningful applications as therapeutic agents During the 1980s a set of technologies to clone modify and express genes encoding MABs was developed These breakthroughs permitted MABs to be genetically engineered which consequently gave them the potential to greatly enhance their therapeutic utility as well as significantly expand their research and diagnostic applications New MABs fragments of MABs bispecific MABs single chain MABs and fusions of MABs with other gene products became available for study

Sugarbaker,2012-12-06 Paul Sugarbaker and his colleagues have persevered in the study and treatment of peritoneal carcinomatosis The peritoneal cavity has many unique and incompletely appreciated properties These properties coupled with the biologic behavior of many cancers results in the seeding and growth of these cancers on the peritoneum Many of these cancers remain localized to the peritoneum only never metastasizing to other sites One possible reason for this may be the obstruction of the afferent lymphatics on the undersurface of the diaphragm The mucopolysaccharides produced by many of these neoplasma are probably viscous enough to obstruct these lymphatics leading to the syndrome of pseudomyxoma peritonei Many of the neoplasms taking residence on the peritoneum have extremely long cell cycle times and are resistant to radiotherapy and many chemotherapeutic agents How ever much can be done for these patients resection of primary cancers omentectomies to reduce ascites formation management of recurrent ascites management of intestinal obstruction nutritional care and hopefully intraperitoneal chemotherapy We have reviewed

Pusztai, 1991 This volume surveys the chemistry biochemistry biosynthesis metabolism and pharmacological properties of lectins Lectins which are most commonly found in plants are widespread natural products with striking biological activities Their specific ability to recognise and bind to simple or complex saccharides facilitates their role as effective information protein molecules As agents of cell to cell recognition lectins promote symbiosis between plants and specific nitrogen fixing soil bacteria As natural defensive molecules they can protect plants against predators such as bacteria fungi and insects As part of our diet lectins are powerful exogenous growth factors in the small intestine and influence our health the digestive function and the bacterial ecology of the alimentary tract Lectins are also important research tools in preparative biochemistry and cell science

Hartley, 2010-07-20 Many plants produce enzymes collectively known as ribosome inactivating proteins RIPs RIPs catalyze

the removal of an adenine residue from a conserved loop in the large ribosomal RNA. The adenine residue removed by this depurination is crucial for the binding of elongation factors. Ribosomes modified in this way are no longer able to carry out protein synthesis. Most RIPs exist as single polypeptides. Type 1 RIPs, which are largely non-toxic to mammalian cells because they are unable to enter them and thus cannot reach their ribosomal substrate. In some instances, however, the RIP forms part of a heterodimer where its partner polypeptide is a lectin. Type 2 RIPs. These heterodimeric RIPs are able to bind to and enter mammalian cells. Their ability to reach and modify ribosomes in target cells means these proteins are some of the most potentially cytotoxic poisons found in nature and are widely assumed to play a protective role as part of the host plant's defenses. RIPs are able to further damage target cells by inducing apoptosis. In addition, certain plants produce lectins lacking an RIP component but which are also cytotoxic. This book focuses on the structure, function, and some potential applications of these toxic plant proteins.

Immunotoxin Methods and Protocols Walter A. Hall, 2008-02-02. Immunotoxins represent a new class of human therapeutics that have widespread applications and a potential that has not yet been fully recognized since they were first conceived of by Paul Ehrlich in 1906. The majority of advances in the development and implementation of immunotoxins has occurred over the last 20 years. The reasons for this use of immunotoxins in basic science and clinical research are the powerful concurrent advances in genetic engineering and receptor physiology. Recombinant technology has allowed investigators to produce sufficient quantities of a homogeneous compound that allows clinical trials to be performed. The identification of specific receptors on malignant cell types has enabled scientists to generate immunotoxins that have had positive results in clinical trials. As more cellular targets are identified in coming years, additional trials will be conducted in different disease states affecting still larger patient populations. Modulation of the immune system to decrease the humoral response to immunotoxins may improve their overall efficacy. As increasingly more effective compounds are generated, it will be necessary to decrease the local and systemic toxicity associated with these agents, and methods for doing so are presently being developed. The work presented in Immunotoxin Methods and Protocols focuses on three specific areas of immunotoxin investigation that are being conducted by experts throughout the world. The first section describes the construction and development of a variety of immunotoxins.

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
