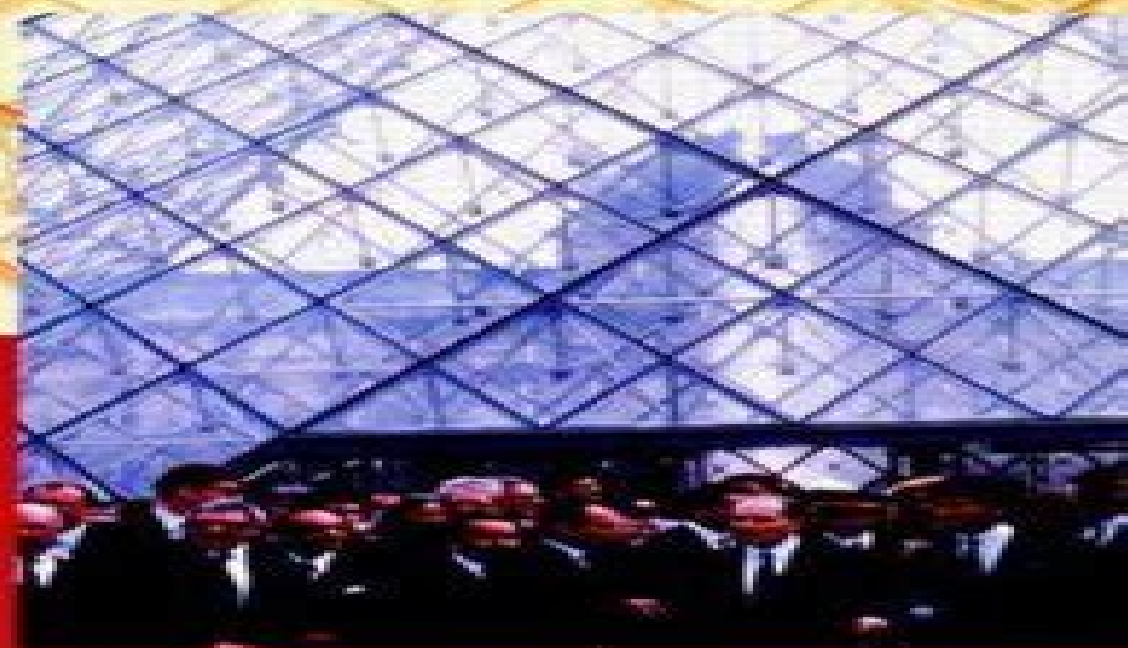

France Since 1945 Robert Gildea, 1996 The last fifty years have seen immense challenges for the French constructing a new European order building a modern economy searching for a stable political system It has also been a time of anxiety and doubt The French have had to come to terms with the legacy of the German Occupation the political and social implications of the influx of foreign immigrants the destruction of traditional rural life and the threat of Anglo American culture to French language and civilization Robert Gildea's account examines French politics society and culture as well as France's role in the world from 1945 to 1995 He looks at France's attempt to recover national greatness after the Second World War its attempt to deal with the fear of German resurgence by building the European Community the Algerian war and the later development of a neo colonialism to preserve its influence in Africa and the Pacific He traces the career of General de Gaulle the revolution of 1968 and the trend towards both political consensus and political disillusionment He also examines the rise and fall of the French intellectual the changing cultural policy of the state and the threat of feminism regionalism and multiculturalism to the ideal of the One and Indivisible Republic

The Gaullist Attack on Canada, 1967-1997 J. F. Boshier, 1999 What lay behind Charles de Gaulle's Vive le Québec libre speech in Montreal on 24 July 1967 Philippe Rossillon's activities in New Brunswick Belgium and Africa and the sinking of Greenpeace's Rainbow Warrior in New Zealand in 1985 J F Boshier argues that the motivation behind all these incidents was a policy of underhanded imperial ambition on the part of France In *The Gaullist Attack on Canada* he contends that French nationalists have been at work behind the screen of harmless fraternising of international francophonie in order to stimulate French

revolutionary nationalism in Quebec and elsewhere and that the Gaullist ideology behind these attempts rests on a set of myths about past events age old resentment of the English speaking nations and a deep rooted belief in the superiority of France its language and its culture The Gaullist Attack on Canada reveals a phase of French imperialism that poses a threat to Canadian Confederation Since the 1960s Boshier argues de Gaulle and his followers have conspired to stimulate Quebec separatism as part of their larger goal to revive France's role as a great power He bases his case on the evidence of France's actions in other former French colonies especially in Africa as well as the writings of such leading Gaullist conspirators as Bernard Dorin Pierre Claude Mallen Pierre de Menthon and Philippe Rossillon who have boasted about their efforts to win Quebec away from Canada for France Boshier criticises the Canadian government for its failure to respond to or even to recognise the Gaullist threat The Under Secretary of State for External Affairs in the 1960s Marcel Cadieux wanted to take vigorous steps against the Gaullist mafia but was overruled by his political superiors Boshier argues that even now by standing up to French aggression the government might weaken the separatist movement in Quebec or at least turn the tide of political support for it

France Since 1800 D. L. L. of the War Bennett's painstaking research has unearthed primary source material in both Britain and France including Squadron records diaries oral histories and memoirs In the post war period the idea of French pilots serving with the RAF seemed anachronistic to both sides For the French nation the desire to draw a veil over the war years helped to obscure many aspects of the past and for the British the idea of French pilots did not accord with the myths of the Few to whom so much was owed Those French pilots who served had to make daring escapes Classed as deserters they risked court martial and execution if caught They would play a vital role on D Day and the battle for control of the skies which followed

Tristan Tzara and Mário de Andrade's Journeys from Ethnography to the Avant-Garde Nefeli Zygopoulou, 2021-05-14 This book presents a comparative study of Tristan Tzara 1896 1963 and Mário de Andrade 1893 1945 analysing their contributions to oral language traditions and to the body of criticism on modernism This is the first work to offer an analysis of Tzara's posthumously published prose *Personnage d'insomnie* and the first in the English language that explores de Andrade's libretto for the opera *Caf* as well as other examples of their poetry and prose The Romanian Jewish poet and writer Tzara later a naturalised French citizen became a central figure in the European avant garde from 1916 when he took part in the Dada Movement Mário de Andrade the Brazilian poet writer and musicologist of mixed origins was a contemporary of Tzara and a similarly central figure in the 1922 São Paulo Modern Art Week that defined Brazilian Modernism Both emerged from very different backgrounds but they followed a parallel creative path This book discusses their research and adaptation of various language manifestations ethnopoeitics and folk traditions that led them to the creation of distinct and individual styles The historical and socio political events of the late 1930s would later prompt both authors to develop militant poetics Through chronologically compatible case studies the reader will discover that Tzara and de Andrade alongside their playful language actively criticised cultural imperialism and advocated against hate Journeys can be physical and intellectual they can crisscross leave traces and overlap This book takes

the reader from two starting points a small Romanian town in the foothills of the Carpathians and a two storey house in an unusually tranquil street in S o Paulo Brazil to the heart of the twentieth century avant garde As it shows Tristan Tzara and M rio de Andrade traversed borders and geographical points and their poetics meet in Mozambique Parisian caf s and Bantu chants

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
