Kaput, 2020-10-07 The central question addressed in Foundations for the Future in Mathematics Education is this What kind of understandings and abilities should be emphasized to decrease mismatches between the narrow band of mathematical understandings and abilities that are emphasized in mathematics classrooms and tests and those that are needed for success beyond school in the 21st century This is an urgent question In fields ranging from aeronautical engineering to agriculture and from biotechnologies to business administration outside advisors to future oriented university programs increasingly emphasize the fact that beyond school the nature of problem solving activities has changed dramatically during the past twenty years as powerful tools for computation conceptualization and communication have led to fundamental changes in the levels and types of mathematical understandings and abilities that are needed for success in such fields For K 12 students and teachers questions about the changing nature of mathematics and mathematical thinking beyond school might be rephrased to ask If the goal is to create a mathematics curriculum that will be adequate to prepare students for informed citizenship as well as preparing them for career opportunities in learning organizations in knowledge economies in an age of increasing globalization how should traditional
