- Native Peoples Develop Diverse Cultures
 - Debate over when and how the first people came, most likely from NII.
 Assa
 - Believed a growth of glaciers between 38,000 and 14,000 B.C. led to a drop in sea levels and created a land bridge in the Bering Strait, known as Beringia
 - First people likely came over 20,000 to 25,000 years ago during a warming trend following mammoths, musk over, and wholly chinoceroses
 - Eventually, ice returned, and magrants pushed inland.
 - Manimoth's disappeared approx. 10,000; people became dependent on fish, plants, other meats to survive.
 - Some communities began establishing agriculture, led to permanent settlements
 - Horticulture- people working on small plots of land with simple tools- developed in present-day Mexico
 - Beans, squash, and corn offered a well-rounded duet
 - High yields produced surpluses of food allowed for trade
 - Led to economic developments and diversification of societies
 - Small bands of hunters and gatherers in deserts and forests.
 - Civilizations on swamplands, grasslands, and mountains
- The Aztecs, Mayn, and the incas
 - Large, wealthy cyclications that were dominant in the 15° century.
 - Artiscs (Mexica) built Tenochtitlan (present day Mexico City)
 - Used imagation and cultivation, developed written language
 - Class structure: priests and nobles
 - Nobles-warner class, landowners, employed serfs and slaves
 - Priests-promised fertility, demanded human sacrifices
 - Vast trade networks
 - Mayana settled the Yoostan peninsuls and rainforests (present day Gustemals)
 - Large cities with elaborate water storage systems.
 - Built large galaces for the Gods
 - Learned mathematics, astronomy, heroglyphocs, and calendars
 - Began to decline around 900 A.D.
 - Likely the result of drought and heavy taxation.
 - Began trading with the Arters
 - The lacans settled in the Andes Mountains
 - Had expansive road and parmson systems.
 - Pertile mountain valleys allowed for crops
 - Gold, silver, and irrigation systems
 - Human sacrifice to keep natural disasters and military defeat away
