Roth, 2019-03-01 Architecture requires a broad definition It involves more than simply questions of style esoteric theory or technical progress it is the physical record of a culture s relationship to its technology and the land and most important of the system of values concerning men s relationships with one another Hence this volume like my Concise Hist **Modern Architectural Theory** Harry Francis Mallgrave, 2009-07-13 Modern Architectural Theory is the first book to provide a comprehensive survey of architectural theory primarily in Europe and the United States during three centuries of development In this synthetic overview Harry Mallgrave examines architectural discourse within its social and political context He explores the philosophical and conceptual evolution of its ideas discusses the relation of theory to the practice of building and most importantly considers the words of the architects themselves as they contentiously shaped Western architecture He also examines the compelling currents of French rationalist and British empiricist thought radical reformation of the theory during the Enlightenment the intellectual ambitions and historicist debates of the nineteenth century and the distinctive varieties of modern theory in the twentieth century up to the profound social upheaval of the 1960s Modern Architectural Theory challenges many assumptions about architectural modernism and uncovers many new dimensions of the debates about modernism
