Arguing And Justifying:

Autonomy Platonism and the Indispensability Argument Russell Marcus, 2015-06-11 Mathematical platonism is the view that mathematical statements are true of real mathematical objects like numbers shapes and sets One central problem with platonism is that numbers shapes sets and the like are not perceivable by our senses In contemporary philosophy the most common defense of platonism uses what is known as the indispensability argument According to the indispensabilist we can know about mathematics because mathematics is essential to science Platonism is among the most persistent philosophical views Our mathematical beliefs are among our most entrenched They have survived the demise of millennia of failed scientific theories Once established mathematical theories are rarely rejected and never for reasons of their inapplicability to empirical science Autonomy Platonism and the Indispensability Argument is a defense of an alternative to indispensability platonism The autonomy platonist believes that mathematics is independent of empirical science there is purely mathematical evidence for purely mathematical theories which are even more compelling to believe than empirical science Russell Marcus begins by contrasting autonomy platonism and indispensability platonism He then argues against a variety of indispensability arguments in the first half of the book In the latter half he defends a new approach to a traditional platonistic view one which includes appeals to a priori but fallible methods of belief acquisition including mathematical intuition and a natural adoption of ordinary mathematical methods In the end Marcus defends his intuition based autonomy platonism against charges that the autonomy of mathematics is viciously circular This book will be useful to researchers graduate students and advanced undergraduates with interests in the philosophy of mathematics or in the connection between science and mathematics

Justifying Strict Liability Marco Cappelletti, 2022 The imposition of strict liability in tort law is controversial and its theoretical foundations are the object of vigorous debate Why do or should we impose strict liability on employers for the torts committed by their employees or on a person for the harm caused by their children animals activities or things In responding to this type of questions legal actors rely on a wide variety of justifications Justifying Strict Liability explores in a comparative perspective the most significant arguments that are put forward to justify the imposition of strict liability in four legal systems two common law England and the United States and two civil law France and Italy These justifications include risk accident avoidance the deep pockets argument loss spreading victim protection reduction in administrative costs and individual responsibility By looking at how these arguments are used across the four legal systems this book considers a variety of patterns which characterise the reasoning on strict liability The book also assesses the justificatory weight of the arguments showing that these can assume varying significance in the four jurisdictions and that such variations reflect different views as to the values and goals which inspire strict liability and tort law more generally Overall the book seeks to improve our understanding of strict liability to shed light on the justifications for its imposition and to enhance our understanding of the different tort cultures featuring in the four legal systems studied

Justifying the Obligation to Die Ilan Zvi Baron, 2009-06-16 One of the state's key features is its ability to oblige its citizens to risk their lives on its behalf by being sent into war However what is it about the state or its equivalent that makes this obligation justifiable Justifying the Obligation to Die is the first monograph to explore systematically how this obligation has been justified Using key texts from political philosophy and just war theory it provides a critical survey of how this obligation has been justified and using illustrations from Zionist thought and practice demonstrates how the various arguments for the obligation have functioned The obligation to risk one's life for the state is often presumed by theorists and practitioners who take the state for granted but for the Zionists a people without a state but in search of one and who have little history of state based political thought it became necessary to explain this obligation As such this book examines Zionism as a Jewish political theory reading it alongside the tradition of Western political thought and critiques how Zionist thought and practice sought to justify this obligation to risk one's life in war what Michael Walzer termed the obligation to die Finally turning to the political thought of Hannah Arendt the author suggests how the obligation could become justifiable although never entirely justified For the obligation to become at all justifiable the type of politics that the state enables must respect human diversity and individuality and restrict violence so that violence is not a continuation of politics

The Justification of Europe Jürgen Neyer, 2012-10-18 The debate on the EU's legitimacy has long suffered from a number of serious misunderstandings Supranational politics Jürgen Neyer argues is not about the making of public order in Europe but about internalizing external effects and fostering the individual right to justification The concepts of state and democracy he suggests are essentially useless for understanding and justifying the EU's structures and practices The European Union is a dualistic polity that is not replacing but supplementing its member states Its modus of operation is the joint exercise of pooled competencies on the normative basis of the principle of mutual recognition He goes on to show that the EU provides an important cure to many of the problems that modern democracies are facing in a globalizing world Legal integration internalizes external effects and

Courtois, 2008-08-17 Safety is a paradoxical system property It remains immaterial intangible and invisible until a failure an accident or a catastrophe occurs and too late reveals its absence And yet a system cannot be relied upon unless its safety can be explained demonstrated and certified The practical and difficult questions which motivate this study concern the evidence and the arguments needed to justify the safety of a computer based system or more generally its dependability Dependability is a broad concept integrating properties such as safety reliability availability maintainability and other related characteristics of the behaviour of a system in operation How can we give the users the assurance that the system enjoys the required dependability How should evidence be presented to certification bodies or regulatory authorities What best practices should be applied How should we decide whether there is enough evidence to justify the release of the system To help answer these daunting questions a method and a framework are proposed for the justification of the dependability of a computer based system The approach specifically aims at dealing with the difficulties raised by the validation of software Hence it should be of wide applicability despite being mainly based on the experience of assessing Nuclear Power Plant instrumentation and control systems important to safety To be viable a method must rest on a sound theoretical background

Justification without Awareness Michael Bergmann, 2006-05-18 Virtually all philosophers agree that for a belief to be epistemically justified it must satisfy certain conditions Perhaps it must be supported by evidence Or perhaps it must be reliably formed Or perhaps there are some other good making features it must have But does a belief's justification also require some sort of awareness of its good making features The answer to this question has been hotly contested in contemporary epistemology creating a deep divide among its practitioners Internalists insist that such awareness is required for justification whereas externalists insist that it isn't The first part of Michael Bergmann's book argues that internalism faces an inescapable dilemma either it leads to vicious regress problems and ultimately radical skepticism or it is entirely unmotivated The second part of the book begins by developing the author's own externalist theory of justification one imposing both a proper function and a no defeater requirement Bergmann concludes by demonstrating the failure of two prominent critiques of externalism namely that it is infected with epistemic circularity and that it cannot respond adequately to skepticism Together the two parts of the book provide a decisive refutation of internalism and a sustained defense of externalism Moreover they do so while placing a high priority on making the author's opponents feel that their positions and objections are understood

Local Theories of Argument Dale Hample, 2021-03-25 Argumentation is often understood as a coherent set of Western theories birthed in Athens and developing throughout the Roman period the Middle Ages the Enlightenment and Renaissance and into the present century Ideas have been nuanced developed and revised but still the outline of argumentation theory has been recognizable for centuries or so it has seemed to Western scholars The 2019 Alta Conference on Argumentation co-sponsored by the National Communication Association and the American Forensic Association aimed to question the generality of these intellectual traditions This resulting collection of essays deals with the possibility of having local theories of argument local to a particular time a particular kind of issue a particular place or a particular culture Many of the papers argue for reconsidering basic ideas about arguing to represent the uniqueness of some moment or location of discourse Other scholars are more comfortable with the Western traditions and find them congenial to the analysis of arguments that originate in discernibly distinct circumstances The papers represent different methodologies cover the experiences of different nations at different times examine varying sorts of argumentative events speeches court decisions food choices and sound explore particular personal identities and the issues highlighted by them and have different overall orientations to doing argumentation scholarship Considered together the essays do not generate one simple conclusion but they stimulate reflection about the particularity or generality of the experience of arguing and therefore the scope of our theories
