The authors examine the further development of the bicycle for such specific purposes as racing, portability and all-terrain use and they describe the evolution of bicycle components including seats, transmission, brakes, lights, at first candle-based and carriers, racks, panniers, saddlebags, child seats and sidecars. They consider not only commercially successful designs but also commercial failures that pointed the way to future technological developments. And they debunk some myths about bicycles, for example the mistaken but often cited idea that Leonardo sketched a chain-drive bike in his notebooks. Despite the bicycle's long history and mass appeal, its technological history has been neglected. This volume, with its engaging and wide-ranging coverage, fills that gap. It will be the starting point for all future histories of the bicycle.

For 3 decades the EU has harmonised many aspects of copyright law via EU legislation and the case law of the Court of Justice of the EU (CJEU). However, it is not known whether national courts actually comply with it as a comprehensive analysis of the national case law has not yet been done.
