The Correspondence of Ford Madox Ford and Stella Bowen Ford Madox Ford, Stella Bowen, 1993 Ford Madox Ford novelist poet critic champion of young authors travel writer chronicler of his own times was a man mad about writing As Ezra Pound observed Ford actually lived the heroic artistic life that Yeats talked about An incorrigible bohemian who passed as a nice old gentleman at a tea party Ford devoted himself to literature and the arts founding two important literary magazines The English Review and the transatlantic review and writing over eighty books including The Good Soldier and Parade s End
